

MSC Summer Schools 2019

University of Exeter Medical School

The Medical Schools Council is working with Exeter Medical School to offer a series of free summer schools focusing on supporting applicants, as well as offering funding for students to gain places at a number of other pre-existing medical summer schools. The summer schools will be a residential event lasting four days. The initiative has been funded by Health Education England and is aimed at young people from areas of England where few students apply to study medicine.

To be eligible, a student must be in, or has been in, local authority care

Or hold a minimum of two of the following:

- Studying in a school that achieved below the national average Attainment 8 score at GCSE, or has attended such a school until the age of 16
- From a school with a high percentage of students receiving free school meals
- Living in a geographical area with low levels of progression onto higher education
- A young carer
- From a family where the parents do not have a university degree from the UK or abroad
- In receipt of or eligible for free school meals or the 16–19 Bursary Fund or Discretionary Learner Support or Means Tested Benefit
- Estranged from parents or guardians and/or be an asylum seeker or refugee
- Be a young carer
